

Maynooth Wave Energy Workshop 2020



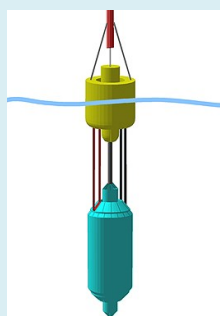
The Centre for Ocean Energy Research (COER) at Maynooth University Ireland will host its 6th workshop event on Friday 24th January 2020. The scope of the workshop will cover a range of topics across wave energy conversion, with a broad focus on modelling, control and estimation/forecasting, and will feature a range of presentations from international and local speakers with some focus on the culmination of the SFI project entitled “Development of the next generation of controllers for wave energy devices”. An open forum discussion will also be hosted and we welcome topic suggestions for the forum.

The event is limited to 100 delegates (places allocated on a first-come, first-served basis) and a nominal registration fee of €30 will be charged to cover hospitality (lunch and 2 coffee-breaks included). We are also soliciting a call for posters (see below) to complement our set of invited oral presentations.
